SELF CARE ITEMS TO PACK FOR WORKING ON SITES

Site Access

- Australian government issued photo identification (e.g. Driver's Licence, Passport, etc.)
- Permits, licences and/or trade tickets (if applicable).
- Site access letter (if applicable).

Personal Care and Medical

- High-Vis warm jacket.
- Bamboo socks or two pairs of thick socks.
- Reusable face mask for travelling.
- Toothbrush and toothpaste.
- Shampoo and conditioner.
- Body wash or soap.
- Deodorant.
- Moisturiser
- Insect/mosquito repellent (e.g. Aerogard, Bushman, etc.) and a fly net.
- Aloe Vera Gel (for after sun care/sunburn).
- Prescription medicines should be stored in a zip-lock bag (remember to pack enough for the duration of the full swing, plus a contingency supply).
- Mini First Aid Kit (e.g. Band-aids, antiseptic cream; throat lozenges, tissues and hand sanitiser or wipes).

Hydration and Sun Safety

- Broad-brimmed or bucket hat.
- SPF50+ sunscreen.
- Sunglasses.
- Refillable water bottle.

Power and Communications

- Mobile phone and charging cable. Please note, many of the remote sites in Australia are primarily supported Telstra.
- Small power board (if using multiple devices and/or appliances) and extension cord.

Reusable Food Storage Containers and Snacks

- Reusable food storage containers for meals and snacks. Some site villages no longer supply single-use containers.
- Snacks/lollies (as local stores are expensive) and a zip-lock plastic bag to store snacks/lollies.

Laundry

- Small wash bag pegs and fold-up basket.
- Sites provide washing powder. If you have sensitive skin, please bring your own washing powder.

Other Information

- Do not overpack (i.e. pack what you are able to carry).
- Western Australia observes strict quarantine rules, so declare any perishables and [check this website](#) if you are unsure before you travel.
- Sealed bags of snacks/lollies are permitted when travelling.
